- Monitoring a sector of the pest-proof fence
- Monitoring tracking tunnels in the enclosures
- Monitoring tracking tunnels out over the mountain (*every 3 months*)

Planting and weeding - *every Friday fortnight*

- Planting and weeding around the southern enclosure and/or wetland areas

Stallholders – *monthly (2nd Sunday of every month)*

- Stall at the Cambridge Market
- Promotions and marketing
- Selling MEIT merchandise
